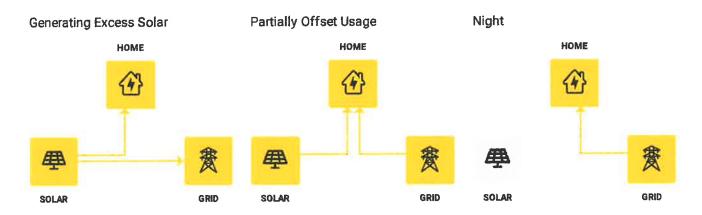

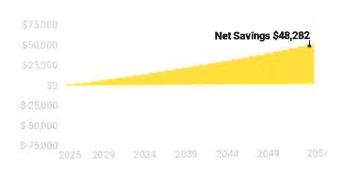

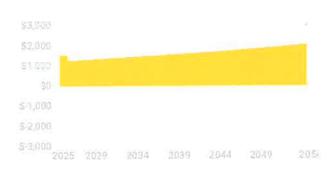

Exclusive Letter of Intent to Develop A Solar Energy Project

This Exclusive Letter of Intent ("LOI"), dated Mar 17 2025, is by and among:

- · Collinsville Memorial Public Library ("Customer"), and
- ARF Solar ("ARF"), the solar Renewable Energy Credit (REC) Approved Vendor, where ARF is the "Developer"

and together are hereby the "Parties" of this agreement.

RECITALS:

Whereas, Customer and Developer desire to agree to terms whereby the Developer will supply a system to the Customer including the design, sizing, placement and installation of a solar photovoltaic energy system as conceptually proposed in Exhibit A (the "System"), with final mount to be determined in accordance with this LOI. Whereas, Customers are interested in the System in order to reduce its electric bill, reduce its environmental footprint, and incorporate the cost of necessary electrical upgrades into the solar federal grant.

Now Therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth below, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

AGREEMENT:

1. Exclusivity

The Customer agrees to give the Developers a period of 1 year, from the date of execution of this LOI, the sole and exclusive right to conduct discovery and due diligence necessary to determine the feasibility of a System for Customer at the property referenced in Exhibit A (the "Property"), provided, however, that the foregoing exclusivity will not apply and this LOI will expire where (a) Customer believes that Developer is no longer competitive in terms of pricing, quality, or other terms and conditions of service, (b) a force majeure event or other act of God exists, (c) Developer has breached or failed to meet a timeline within 60-days required by this LOI or another written agreement between the parties, (d) either interconnection approval from Ameren and acceptance into the Illinois Solar For All Program are not achieved within 120-days of the execution of this LOI, or (f) Customer does not within 120-days of the execution of this agreement execute either the Owner's Representative Agreement referenced in paragraph 7 herein or accepted the EPC Contract referenced in Paragraph 8 herein.

2. Compliance with Discovery

The Customer will reasonably comply with the Developer to give reasonable access to visit and review the site, assist the Developer by providing necessary building information, and access to the last 12-month history of the electrical utility billings of the Customer, in order for the Developers to determine the project's feasibility. Such compliance shall be provided by Customer at Developers' expense and without material interruption to the Customer's business operations or use of the property.

3. Utility Approvals

Customer agrees to assist and fully cooperate with the Developer in obtaining necessary permits, licenses, and approvals in connection with the installation, operation and maintenance of the System, including the submission of applications for interconnection of the System with the local utility. If the pending interconnection for the System is not signed by the Customer, then all such permits, licenses, and approvals will be terminated by Developer.

4. Development Costs

Developer will bear the cost for the development of this project.

5. Federal Investment Tax Credit and Solar Renewable Energy Credits (SRECs)

Customer agrees to sign over the Federal Investment Tax Credit and Solar Renewable Energy Credits (SRECs) to ARF under the agreement that ARF will procure and install the System at no cost to the Customer.

6. Representation

Customer and Developer will negotiate in good faith for the Developer to become the Owner's Representative (Customer being the Owner) for the delivery of the System under a Master Engineering, Procurement, and Construction (EPC) contract.





7. Solar EPC Contract

The EPC Contract will include a detailed schedule for all activities required to perform the services and work required for the planning, design, sizing, placement and installation of the System for the construction, design, supply or procurement contracts, except for mutually agreed upon and signed change orders. The EPC Contract will also include verified application possibilities for all possible rebates, grants, RECs, etc., and a computation of future savings and revenue streams in an honest and transparent manner.

8. Confidentiality; No Publicity

Customer acknowledges that Developer will be employing proprietary intellectual property in Developers' efforts to deliver the Binding EPC Contract to Customer in accordance with this LOI. In addition, the Parties acknowledge that in connection herewith either Party may disclose or make available to the other Party information about its business affairs, operations, confidential intellectual property, trade secrets, third-party confidential information and other non-public, sensitive or proprietary information (collectively, "Confidential Information"). The receiving Party shall: (A) protect and safeguard the confidentiality of the other Party's Confidential Information with at least the same degree of care as the receiving Party would protect its own Confidential Information, but in no event with less than a commercially reasonable degree of care; (B) not use the other Party's Confidential Information, or permit it to be accessed or used, for any purpose other than to exercise its rights or perform its obligations under this LOI; and (C) not disclose any such Confidential Information to any person or entity, except (i) to its employees, consultants, legal counsel, accountants, and other professionals, in each case, who need to know the Confidential Information to assist the receiving Party, or act on its behalf, to exercise its rights or perform its obligations under this LOI, or (ii) as required by governmental authority or court order. The receiving Party will be responsible for any breach of this Section caused by any of the foregoing persons.

9. Indemnification

Developer shall indemnify, defend, and save harmless Customer, its officers, directors, shareholders, agents, representatives and employees against and from any damages, liability or claim thereof (including, but not limited to, actual attorney fees and costs) whether for injury to persons, including death, economic loss or damage to property (i) occurring on or arising out of the use of the Property; and (ii) Developers failure to comply with the terms of this LOI.

Please let me know if you have any questions or feedback regarding the preliminary system designs, I will let Tisha address if there are any documents that we are needing from you at this point.

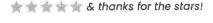

These checklists are completed before the day's installation can begin. Our Job Hazard Analysis application integrates our project team and records. This integration allows the safety manager, field project coordinator, site supervisor, or crew lead to communicate adverse safety conditions immediately.
